

- The TXSCL meeting begins at 10:30.
- Madison Whitaker explains her ideas for merchandise to sell at state and nationals
  - To start, TXSCL shirts with a the same design as the red shirts with blue print; however, this time the shirt will be navy blue and the print will be red. Her plan is to buy 100 shirts at \$5.86 each (without tax). We can then sell the shirts for about \$12-\$15 to make anywhere from ~\$600 to ~\$900 profit.
  - Her next idea is to print 200 TXSCL buttons. These would have a royal blue background with the TXSCL logo in red. There is also the option of printing the State Convention theme on some buttons along with an outline of Texas. We could print 200 buttons at \$0.24 each (and get free shipping). Each button could retail for \$1.00 to make \$152 profit.
- Walton Schmidt takes a quick break to give the TXSCL report to the TSJCL board. He explains some of the merchandise ideas as well as the work the TXSCL officers have been doing since the last board meeting.
- The Board takes a break for lunch and the tour of the school at 11:45

- Katherine Salinas begins parsing the TXSCL Constitution in an effort to make revisions.
- Madison Whitaker makes some adjustments to the design of the buttons based on the State Convention theme. The expected profit is now about \$140
- Katherine Salinas explains her amendments to the TXSCL Constitution. Many are syntactical, grammatical, and practical changes that are simply common sense.
- Madison Whitaker continues researching; due to her being fantastic, she finds an even cheaper provider for t-shirts. She is not done yet, however, and is going to keep looking.
- The board meeting ends at 15:30 with Madison prepared to purchase shirts as soon as she consults Ms. Dill, the money handler.
